

Minutes Calmar City Council June 9, 2020

Mayor Frana called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. on June 9, 2020 at the Calmar Fire Station. The meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance. Present were: Kleve, Kirkeberg, Schissel, Sabelka and Gerlich.

Also present: Sheila Bullerman, Michele Elsbernd, Joe Ward, Junior Boyer, Troy Anderson, Leah Knutson, Kristin Vanden Brink and Tara Hoffert

Kristin Vanden Brink suggested certain procedures to follow or consider from the Iowa Department of Public Health (CDC Guidelines); Your lifeguards are there to keep people from drowning. She said that a person has to be next to someone with COVID for at least 15 minutes before contracting COVID and it usually takes a lot less time than 15 minutes to save a life.

Tara Hoffert representing our ICAP insurance said that ICAP will stand behind the City of Calmar if we follow the guidelines; Tara was also going to get a waiver form for us to have parents sign off on when they purchased their pool pass.

Documenting is also a key to the success of our pool season; People should take accountability for themselves.

Junior said that 50% capacity of our pool would be 90 people (in the water).

The City of Calmar is also considering buying a fogger (going to take a look at City of Forts fogger).

Leah Knutson has 10 full-time lifeguards and 2 sub lifeguards lined up for the 2020 season. There was some concern regarding August and not having enough lifeguards (going back to college, sports, etc.).

Motion by Kirkeberg, second by Schissel to start getting the pool ready immediately to open as soon as possible and charge \$32.00 for an individual pass. Aye: Kleve, Sabelka, Schissel, Kirkeberg and Gerlich. Motion carried.

Motion by Schissel, second by Kirkeberg to NOT approve building permit (metal shipping container) for Loren Schmitt at 101 S Fredrick St. Aye: Kleve, Sabelka, Schissel, Kirkeberg, and Gerlich. Motion carried. Matt Vine will submit building permit after he gets back from overseas.

Motion by Kleve, second by Sabelka to adjourn. Aye: Kleve, Sabelka, Schissel, Kirkeberg and Gerlich. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:00 p.m.
